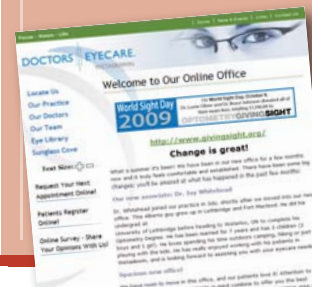

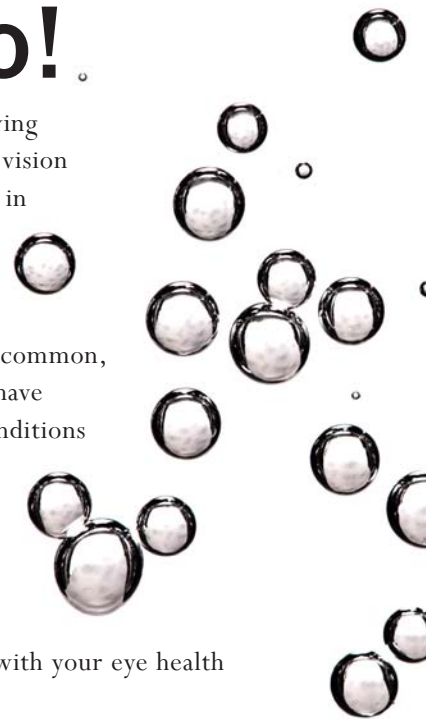

Although floaters aren’t uncommon, flashes of light – or if you have glaucoma and other eye conditions – can indicate warning signs of something more serious.
